POINTS SCALE

To ensure the success of the Teen Leadership Council, each member will be responsible for earning at least 30 points per school year.

There will be several opportunities to achieve that goal, but those members who are not active participants of the Council may not be asked to return the following year.

Please contact us if at any point there is any concern about meeting this goal.

Opportunities for Points:

- **Community Engagement Activity:** **15 points**
 - Bulk of the points fall here, failure to participate in a Community Engagement Activity will automatically disqualify member from achieving points goal
 - Must be pre-approved with TLC Leadership
 - Ideas detailed at end of document

- **Attending Monthly Meetings:** **2 points per meeting**
 - 6-8 total meetings/school year
 - RSVPing “No” prior to missed meeting: **1 point per missed meeting (up to 4 points max)**

- **Events:**
 - **Attend a Masterworks Concert:** **5 points per concert**
 - Will be given access to free tickets
 - Submit a written paragraph critique of the performance within one week about your experience, ideas, timeframe, feel, etc.
 - Share the event on social media prior to attending (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter)

- **Volunteer at an Event:** **3 points per hour**
 - **Christmas Tree Elegance:**
 - Set up includes assisting 12 Tree Teams move decorated trees and prizes to assigned locations on the second floor of the Davenport Hotel and 6 (six) trees on the second floor at River Park Square. Assistance may include the set up and movement of stanchions and ropes, assisting with various tasks as needed in securing the prize items to the trees and or other displays. Multiple trips to and from the “design” location may be necessary at both locations.
 - Set up at the Davenport – Monday, 12/2, 8:00am until done in the evening
 - Set up at River Park Square – Monday, 12/2, 4:00pm until done

- Take down would include assisting the Tree Teams and winners in wrapping the Tree with wide cellophane wrap and assisting the winners in getting their prizes to their vehicles via elevators and the loading docks at both the Davenport and River Park Square. Assistance at both locations might also include the take down and storage of stanchions, ropes and miscellaneous displays
 - Take down at Davenport – Sunday, 12/15, 8:30am until approximately 2:00pm
 - Take down at River Park Square – Monday, 12/16, 5:00pm until approximately 8:00pm
- **UpScale Sale:**
 - Set up includes unpacking boxes, washing/polishing items, sweeping/vacuumping, pricing items, placing items for sale on tables.
 - Dates TBD: starts first week of May: shifts 9am-12pm, 12pm-3pm, and 3pm to 5pm, other times to be cleared through SSA.
 - Sale Day help includes wrapping sold items, monitor sales floor, helping as needed
 - Dates TBD: last week in May
 - Take down/clean up after the sale includes cleaning, sweeping/vacuumping, packing unsold items, helping as needed
 - Dates TBD: last week in May
- **Ancient Tales of Magic:**
 - Help at pre-concert and intermission activities at The Fox. Arrive approximately 1.5 hours prior to the show and stay through the end of the show. 2 complimentary tickets included.
 - Saturday, 10/26, 2pm concert
 - Saturday, 10/26, 8pm concert
 - Sunday, 10/27, 3pm concert
 - Help set up prior to the first show (details TBD) or tear down and put away décor and props from pre-concert and intermission activities after the last show, Sunday 10/27
- **Nutcracker:**
 - Help at pre-concert and intermission activities at The Fox. Arrive approximately 1.5 hours prior to the show and stay through the end of the show. 2 complimentary tickets included.
 - Thursday, 12/5, 7:30pm concert
 - Friday, 12/6, 7:30pm concert
 - Saturday, 12/7, 2pm concert
 - Saturday, 12/7, 7:30pm concert
 - Sunday, 12/8, 2pm concert
 - Help set up prior to the first show (details TBD) or tear down and put away décor and props from pre-concert and intermission activities after the last show, Sunday 12/8
- **Usher/greet patrons for at concerts and events:**
 - Link Up - May 27, 2020 at 7pm at The Fox
 - Concerts on an as needed, sign up basis
 - Other opportunities will be communicated as they come up

- **Will Call:** hand out will call tickets prior to concerts at The Fox. Arrive approximately 1 hour prior to the show. Emails will be sent out as needs come up.
- **Coat check at a Development Event:** check coats at a stewardship event. Emails will be sent out as needs come up.
- **Stuff programs for Marketing at The Fox:** Emails will be sent out as needs come up
- **Instrument Petting Zoo:**
 - Help at one of Education’s Instrument Petting Zoo by encouraging attendees to try out instruments
 - Spokane Youth Symphony can display a sign
 - More details to come as events are solidified

- **Graphic Design:**
 - **Emails will be sent out as needs come up:** **2 points**
 - For consideration to be used in SSO promotional purposes

 - **Create Teen Leadership Council T-shirt Design:** **2 points**
 - For consideration to be used on TLC t-shirts for events/volunteer opportunities

- **Sharing SSO Social Media Posts:** **1 point each (up to 10)**

- **Write a letter about your experience as a TLC member:** **2 points**
For consideration to be used for promotional purposes
 - Include a quote
 - Write a review on Google/Bing/etc.

- **Do a Masterworks presentation for your class:** **5 points**
 - Must be pre-approved with teacher and TLC Leadership
 - Research an upcoming Masterworks concert’s pieces and do a presentation

- **Provide a lead for a potential Corporate Circle member:** **2 points**
 - Must be pre-approved with TLC Leadership
 - Give provided documentation to a parent or community member who has capacity and interest and get contact information for Council Leader to follow up

- **Go on a sales call with Director of Development:** **4 points**
 - Must be scheduled
 - Research materials and ideas, possibly set up a meeting

- **Job Shadow a Department of your choosing:** **4 points**
 - Must be pre-approved and coordinated with Council Leader

- **Make thank you calls at the office:** **2 points**
 - Must be scheduled

- **Bring a friend to a concert:** 3 points
 - Free tickets will be provided
- **Promote FAST Program:** 2 points
 - Hand out flyers about our student access program
- **Other opportunities will be communicated as they come up:** TBD

Community Engagement Activity Ideas:

Community Engagement Activity must be pre-approved with TLC Leadership by December 15, 2019. 15 points each.

- **Organize a musical instrument petting zoo at a local preschool or elementary school:**
 - The year prior to when students pick instruments for school
 - Need a group of students to help facilitate the event
- **Create a mock Donor Stewardship Event:**
 - Create timeline of event
 - List target group to invite
 - Include price estimates
 - Provide reasoning as to why you chose the things you did
- **If you know someone who went to The Fox prior to its grand re-opening:**
 - Conduct an interview
 - Take photos
 - Get a quote
 - Write up their experience
- **Organize and put on an SSO fundraiser, to benefit Education:**
 - Ideas: car wash, yard sale, bake sale, sell popcorn at Upscale Sale, etc.
- **Create your own Community Engagement Event:**
 - Must be pre-approved by Council Leader
